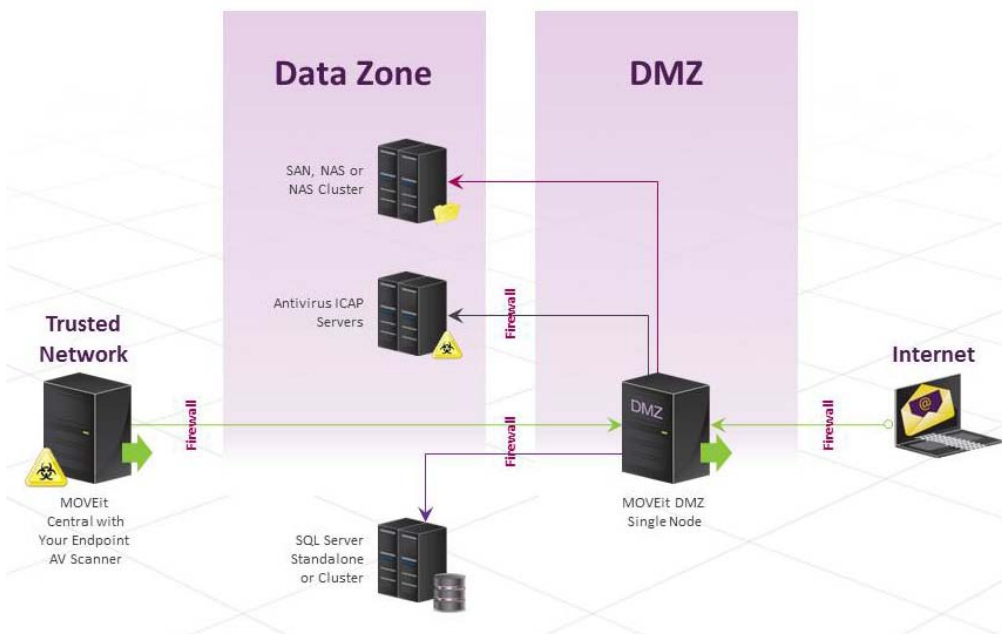

Whether the incoming files are part of an automated workflow between two systems or an ad hoc interaction between people, any infected files are not allowed to enter MOVEit DMZ.

Effective Antivirus Protection

When an infected file is detected, MOVEit DMZ takes the following actions immediately and automatically:

- Rejects the transfer of the infected file
- Alerts the end user that the upload failed due to virus detection
- Logs the virus, timestamp, the scan engine, version, and definition tag
- Reports the list of infect files that have been detected during a specified time period

MOVEit DMZ with Antivirus Integration

MOVEit DMZ communicates with Sophos and Symantec via the universal ICAP protocol to scan all files being uploaded to MOVEit DMZ. Ipswitch recommends and has tested against Symantec Scan Engine 5.2.10 and Sophos SAV Dynamic Interface 2.0. These versions support the ICAP protocol, which is required to interface with MOVEit DMZ and other desktop versions from these same vendors will not integrate with MOVEit DMZ.

Then, as files are uploaded to the MOVEit DMZ solution, it streams a copy of each file to the antivirus server over a secure ICAP-enabled channel. If any type of malware is found, such as software viruses, worms or Trojan horses, MOVEit DMZ destroys the temporary file and prevents the file upload.

MOVEit DMZ also alerts the user that the upload failed due, and logs the critical event details, including the type of virus found, the corresponding timestamp, the scan engine, version and definition tag. Users can generate reports based on these criteria for maximum insight into the number of files detected and blocked during a specific time period.

Immediate, Automatic Virus Protection

MOVEit DMZ offers real-time antivirus integration with Sophos or Symantec ICAP-enabled antivirus solutions, which scan all files

being uploaded to MOVEit DMZ. If an infected file is detected, MOVEit DMZ will immediately and automatically:

- Reject the transfer of the infected file
- Alert end user that upload failed due to virus detection
- Log the virus, timestamp, the scan engine, version and definition tag
- Report the list of infected files that have been detected during a specified time period
